Dear Ms. Watson:

On June 5, 2015, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) submitted a Notice of Cancellation of Service Agreement No. 3204 entered into among PJM, Kingwood Solar W3-149 LLC (Kingwood Solar), and Jersey Central Power & Light Company.¹ PJM states the Service Agreement is being cancelled because Kingwood Solar has decided not to participate in PJM's markets.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. §375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective July 6, 2015, as requested.

The filing was noticed on June 5, 2015, with comments, interventions and protests due on or before June 26, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2015)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
