NOTICE DENYING EXTENSION OF TIME

(July 23, 2015)

On July 14, 2015, the Foundation for Resilient Societies, Inc. (Resilient Societies) filed a motion for an extension of time (motion) to file comments in response to a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NOPR) in the above-referenced proceeding.¹ In its motion, the Resilient Societies request an extension “no less than 30 days after” the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) makes publicly available its “Level 2 Decision” with respect to an appeal filed by Resilient Societies and a June 29, 2015 Level 2 Appeal hearing before a subcommittee of the NERC Board of Trustee. Resilient Societies states that the extension would provide time to fully comment on the full official record of NERC.

Upon consideration, Resilient Societies’ motion is hereby denied.² Comments on the NOPR are due no later than July 27, 2015.
