Reference: Annual Update to Transmission Revenue Requirement

Dear Mr. Allen:

On May 28, 2015, you filed on behalf of Citizens Sunrise Transmission LLC, (Citizens Sunrise), the annual update to Citizens Sunrise's Transmission Revenue Requirement (TRR) and revised Appendix III of the Citizens Sunrise filed Transmission Owner Tariff.¹ Citizens Sunrise proposes to decrease the currently effective TRR of \$15,226,682 by approximately 22.1 percent to \$11,866,735 as a result of a significant reduction in operating costs billed to Citizens Sunrise by San Diego Gas & Electric Company for Citizens Sunrise's share of the operating costs associated with the Sunrise Powerlink Project. Your submittal is accepted for filing, effective June 1, 2015, as requested.

The filing was noticed on May 28, 2015 with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before June 18, 2015. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

¹ Citizens Sunrise states in its submittal that the annual update to the TRR to true-up operating cost data is required under the terms of the Citizens Sunrise Transmission Owner Tariff, Appendix III.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against Citizens Sunrise Transmission LLC.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
