All macros and functions should not be set at a default state to run upon opening the spreadsheet. All formulas, variables, and results should be visible and not hidden. The spreadsheets should not use security features that prevent copying, modification, or printing. The spreadsheets should not contain any links to sources outside of the spreadsheet document.

File your response in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. In particular, 18 C.F.R. § 385.2010 (Rule 2010)) requires that you serve a copy of the response to each person whose name appears on the official service list for this proceeding.

The response by each party listed above should be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by close of business within 5 business days of the date of this letter. Please file all responses under oath (18 C.F.R. § 385.2005) by authorized company representative and include the name, position, and telephone number of the respondent to each item.
