I grant your October 14, 2014 request, as supplemented July 15 and 23, 2015, for Dominion Transmission, Incorporated (DTI) to extend the limits of disturbance at the Mullett Compressor Station in Monroe County, Ohio to stabilize the slope slip problem near the site. The Mullet Compressor Station is part of the Allegheny Storage Project in the above-referenced docket.

Your request is in compliance with environmental condition 5 of the Commission's December 20, 2012 *Order Issuing Certificate* (Order) in the above-referenced docket. DTI has obtained clearance from the Ohio State Historic Preservation Office and we have confirmed that there would be no impacts on wetlands and waterbodies.
