Dear Mr. Levitine:

1. On May 6, 2015, you filed, in the above-referenced proceeding, an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) among the City of Pella, Iowa (Pella); Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc.; and MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican). On May 26, 2015, Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On June 12, 2015, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.¹

2. The Settlement addresses issues related to the operation, compensation and cost allocation with respect to redispatch of certain generation owned and operated by Pella.

3. The Settlement states that “[t]his Settlement shall be subject to the just and reasonable standard of review with respect to all future changes thereto.”²
