Dear Mr. Heinemann:

1. On June 5, 2015, as amended on June 8, 2015, you filed, in the above-referenced proceedings, a Settlement on behalf of the City of Marshfield, Wisconsin (Marshfield). On June 25, 2015, Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On July 13, 2015, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.¹

2. The Settlement addresses Marshfield's proposed rate schedule under which Marshfield will provide Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation or Other Sources Service under Schedule 2 of the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff for an annual revenue requirement of \$19,453.

3. The Settlement provides that "[t]his Settlement is subject to review and modification by the Commission under the just and reasonable standard and subject to the

right of any Party to withdraw from the Settlement and render the Settlement null and void in the event the Commission modifies the Settlement in a manner that is unacceptable to that Party.”²

4. The Settlement resolves all issues in dispute in these proceedings. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission’s approval of this Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in these proceedings.

5. Marshfield is directed to file revised tariff revisions in eTariff format,³ within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, to reflect the Commission’s action in this order.

6. This letter order terminates Docket Nos. ER15-900-000 and ER15-900-001.
