Dear Mr. McGrane:

1. On September 21, 2015, PacifiCorp filed a settlement agreement and offer of settlement (Settlement) between itself, Bonneville Power Administration, Deseret Generation and Transmission Co-operative, Inc., and Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems, to resolve all issues in the above-referenced proceedings associated with PacifiCorp's updated transmission system loss factor for real power losses for use of PacifiCorp's transmission system. On October 13, 2015, Commission Trial Staff submitted initial comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On October 26, 2015, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.<sup>1</sup>

2. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

3. The Settlement was not filed in eTariff format as required by Order No. 714.<sup>2</sup> Within 30 days of the date of this order, PacifiCorp is required to submit a compliance

filing through eTariff to ensure that the electronic tariff data base reflects the Commission's action in this proceeding.
