ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

(Issued May 27, 2016)

1. Southern Company Services, Inc., acting as agent for Alabama Power Company, Georgia Power Company, Gulf Power Company, and Mississippi Power Company (collectively, Southern Companies), filed a notice to inform the Commission that Southern Companies' 2015 true-up informational filing and 2015 Attachment U true-up informational filing for direct assignment charges (2015 True-Up Filings) under Southern Companies' Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff Volume No. 5) (OATT) will be delayed, to on or before June 1, 2016, and Southern Companies will submit by September 30, 2016, their true-up summary report for rate year 2015.
2. Southern Companies explain that, on April 20, 2016, the Commission issued an order granting Mississippi Power Company an extension until May 16, 2016 to file Mississippi Power Company's FERC Form No. 1 for the year ending December 31, 2015.<sup>1</sup>
3. Southern Companies states that due to true-up filings for a rate year being largely predicated upon Southern Companies' FERC Form No. 1 being completed, the above-referenced extension of time for Mississippi Power to file its FERC Form No. 1 necessarily delays Southern Companies' ability to prepare their 2015 True-Up Filings.

4. Notice of Southern Companies' April 29, 2016 filing was published in the *Federal Register*, 81 Fed. Reg. 30,295 (2016), with interventions and protests due on or before May 16, 2016. None were filed.

5. For good cause shown, we grant Southern Companies' requested extension of time to file their 2015 True-Up Filings and true-up summary report for 2015.
