Dear Ms. Starnes:

1. On April 6, 2016, you filed, in the above-referenced proceeding, an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) by the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission (Missouri Municipal). On April 26, 2016, Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On May 10, 2016, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.<sup>1</sup>
2. The Settlement concerns Missouri Municipal's cost-based annual revenue requirement for Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation or Other Sources Service for Missouri Municipal's 22.11 percent ownership interest in Plum Point Energy Station.
3. The Settlement states that "[t]he standard of review the Commission shall apply when acting on proposed modifications to this Settlement under section 205 or 206 of the FPA shall be the 'just and reasonable' standard of review."<sup>2</sup>
