ORDER VACATING CERTIFICATE

(Issued July 5, 2016)

1. On February 6, 2012, the Office of Energy Projects issued a delegated order (February 2012 Order) authorizing DCP Midstream, LP (DCP) pursuant to section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act (NGA)<sup>1</sup> to construct and operate an 11-mile long, 12-inch-diameter pipeline (LaSalle Residue Line) in Weld County, Colorado, connecting DCP's LaSalle Plant, a new non-jurisdictional natural gas processing facility, with the interstate pipeline system of Colorado Interstate Gas Company.<sup>2</sup> The February 2012 Order also issued DCP a blanket certificate pursuant to Part 157, Subpart F, of the Commission's regulations to perform certain routine activities and transactions in conjunction with the operation of the LaSalle Residue Line. Ordering Paragraph (D) of the February 2012 Order required DCP to complete the construction and make the LaSalle Residue Line available for service within two years from the date of the issuance of the order.
2. On May 4, 2016, DCP filed a request to vacate the certificate authorizations granted in the February 2012 Order. DCP states that it never constructed the LaSalle Residue Line and, because of changed circumstances, it no longer intends to do so.
3. In view of the changed circumstances, we will vacate the certificate authorization to construct and operate the LaSalle Residue Line and the blanket certificate authorization issued in the February 2012 Order.
