Dear Mr. Eisenstat:

1. On May 12, 2016, you filed on behalf of CPV Shore, LLC (CPV) an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) concerning CPV's proposed annual revenue requirement for providing reactive service for generating units in the PJM Interconnection, LLC region that resolves all issues in dispute in the above-captioned proceedings. On June 1, 2016, Commission Trial Staff filed comments supporting the Settlement. No reply comments were filed. On June 30, 2016, the settlement judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.<sup>1</sup>

2. Paragraph 11 of the Settlement provides:

Nothing in this Offer of Settlement is intended to affect the Commission's authority, pursuant to Section 205 of the FPA or otherwise, to review, accept (with or without conditions or modifications) or reject this Offer of Settlement, or the legal standard applicable to the exercise of such authority. Once

approved, any modification of the Settlement Rate Schedule would be governed [by] the “just and reasonable” standard of review.<sup>2</sup>

3. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission’s approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

4. CPV is directed to file revised tariff records in eTariff format,<sup>3</sup> within 30 days of this letter order, to reflect the Commission’s action in this letter order.

5. This letter order terminates Docket Nos. ER15-2589-000 and EL16-4-000.
