Dear Ms. Claybour and Ms. White:

1. On July 23, 2015, Scrubgrass Generating Company, L.P. (Scrubgrass) filed a proposed rate schedule, accompanied by testimony and data supporting its proposed revenue requirement, for Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation or Other Sources Service from its 94.7 MW (nameplate) electric generation facility located in Kennerdell, Pennsylvania. On September 21, 2015, the Commission accepted and suspended the proposed rate schedule to become effective September 1, 2015, subject to refund, and set the proposed rate schedule for hearing and settlement judge procedures.¹
2. On May 25, 2016, you filed an offer of settlement in Docket No. ER15-2254-000 on behalf of Scrubgrass (Settlement). On June 14, 2016, Commission Trial Staff filed comments supporting the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On July 8, 2016, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.²

3. The Settlement provides that

The standard of review the Commission shall apply when acting on proposed modifications to this Settlement under section 205 or 206 of the FPA shall be the “just and reasonable” standard of review.³

4. The Settlement appears to be fair, reasonable, and in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission’s approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

5. Scrubgrass is directed to file revised tariff records in eTariff format, within 30 days of the date of this order, to reflect the Commission’s action in this order.⁴

6. This letter order terminates Docket No. ER15-2254-000.
