

**INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT
AMONG THE FERC, USCG AND
RSPA
FOR THE SAFETY AND
SECURITY REVIEW OF
WATERFRONT
IMPORT/EXPORT LNG
FACILITIES**

JURISDICTION

- FERC = terminal siting & approval; construction; inspection.
- DOT = Set and enforce Federal safety standards for transport/storage of LNG; siting, design, installation, construction, initial inspection & testing; O&M.
- USCG = Navigation suitability; safety and security of Port and waterway & all marine facilities.

SCOPE of AGREEMENT

- SAFETY AND SECURITY ISSUES
- WATERFRONT IMPORT/EXPORT FACILITIES
- DESIGN THROUGH OPERATION
- LAND AND MARINE ASPECTS

PURPOSE

- WORK IN A COORDINATED MANNER
- ADDRESS ALL SAFETY AND SECURITY ISSUES INCLUDING TANKERS COMPREHENSIVELY
- AVOID DUPLICATION OF EFFORT
- MAXIMIZE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION
- FERC NEPA LEAD AGENCY

PURPOSE (con't)

- INFORMATION TO BE IN FERC EIS
- IDENTIFY AND RESOLVE ISSUES QUICKLY
- BUILD CONSENSUS ON HAZARD STUDIES AND OTHER EFFORTS
- CONCURRENT PERMITTING

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE AGREEMENT

- SITING AND APPROVAL
- DEVELOP AND SHARE DATA
- PARTICIPATE IN STUDIES
- OPERATION AND INSPECTION
- INFORMAL COMMUNICATION
- DISPUTE RESOLUTION
