
Advancing the Creation of a Dam Sector ISAC

- White House Study¹ Identified the Need for an Information Sharing & Analysis Center (ISAC) for the Dam Sector
 - Coordinated Effort with Federal Agencies and ASDSO
 - Identifying Technical Needs and Logistics for Creation
 - Can be Used by all Dam Owners to Share Intelligence Information

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

Security at Hydropower Projects

Increased Coordination with Emergency and Law Enforcement Agencies

- FERC Continues to Build Bridges Between Dam Owners and Emergency Response Personnel
 - Protect the Public
 - Protect Downstream Infrastructure
 - Protect Downstream Environment
- Coordination Between Dam Owners and Local Law Enforcement Agencies
 - Dam Owners Must Rely on Local Law Enforcement for Response
 - Local and Federal Law Enforcement Can Provide Threat Information



Security at Hydropower Projects

Coordination with U.S.C.G. (COTP)

- Nov 17, 03 EEI requested Commission Assistance:
 - U.S.C.G. 68 Fed. Reg. 60515-544, *et al* interpreted by some COTPs
 - Hydropower Projects must file security assessments/plans
 - U.S.G.S. accept FERC Program as Alternative Security Program (ASW)
- Dec 9, 03 Commission letter to Admiral Collins:
 - Requested acknowledgement of FERC Program as an ASW
 - Reinforced the need to establish coordination and communication
- Jan 5, 04 Rear Admiral Hereth letter to Commission:
 - 33 CFR Part 105 does not apply to hydropower facilities
 - Area Maritime Security Plan participation...



- "...the Area Maritime Security Plan developed pursuant to 33 CFR Part 105 may address the hydropower facilities...within the [COTPs] jurisdiction. I encourage participation of the owners or operators of the hydropower facilities on the Area Maritime Security Committee, which is charged with assisting the [COTP] in the development of the Area Maritime Security Plan."
