NOTICE OF ELECTRIC QUARTERLY REPORTS NEW ENGLAND
OUTREACH SESSION

(June 4, 2004)

On Thursday, June 24, 2004, FERC Electric Quarterly Reports (EQR) staff will hold an EQR Outreach Session for New England filers in conjunction with an EQR Working Group meeting hosted by the New England ISO (ISO-NE) on June 25, 2004. Both meetings will be held at the Radisson Springfield-Enfield in Enfield, CT. The FERC EQR Outreach Session will run from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. (EST) on Thursday. Barbara Bourque (EQR Program Manager) and Mark Blazejowski will discuss general ISO data mapping issues and address any other EQR questions or problems that filers have. Friday's EQR Working Group meeting will address the details of mapping ISO settlement items to EQR product names. Interested individuals should bring someone from their company who is familiar with the ISO-NE operations and settlement statements.
