NOTICE OF ALTERNATIVE  
DISPUTE RESOLUTION CONFERENCE

(November 10, 2004)

On November 5, 2004, the Commission in its “Order Granting in Part and Denying in Part Complaint, Directing Compliance Filing, Conditionally Accepting For Filing Tariff Revisions, Subject To Further Commission Action and Refund, and Establishing Dispute Resolution Service Procedures” in the above-captioned docket, ordered the Director of the Commission’s Dispute Resolution Service to convene a meeting of the parties within seven (7) calendar days after the date of issuance of the Commission’s Order. 109 FERC ¶ 61,153 (2004).
