## Standard Quality Screens for EQR Filings

1. bad seller names (N/A, no sellers, None, etc.)
2. contracts where the buyer is the same as the respondent
3. bad DUNS numbers for sellers (0, 111111111, 000123456, 999999999, etc)
4. contracts with bad DUNS numbers for buyers (0 [when not appropriate], 111111111, 000123456, 999999999, etc)
5. contracts with bad buyer names (ABC, No Customer, none, etc)
6. contracts with bad contract service agreement ids (N/A, xxx, NONE, etc)
7. transactions with bad transaction IDs (NA, N/A, etc.)
8. transactions where energy is not in \$/mWh or \$/kWh and capacity is not in \$/mW or \$/kW
9. transactions involving energy/booked out power sales to ISOs where the interval is greater than an hour
10. transactions with incorrectly reported booked out power sales to an ISO (booked out power defined as “bilateral”)
11. transactions where the transaction end date/time is the same as or after the transaction start date/time
12. transactions involving energy/booked out power sales to ISOs where price is 0 and quantity is not 0
13. transactions where the quantity and total transaction cost are both 0
