Dear Ms. Palazzari:

1. By order issued July 29, 2005, the Commission accepted and suspended tariff sheets filed by El Paso Natural Gas Company (El Paso), including Sheet No. 27A, to become effective January 1, 2006, subject to refund, and set the proposed rates for hearing.¹ On August 25, 2005, El Paso filed the above-referenced tariff sheet to correct a minor error on Sheet No. 27A.

2. El Paso states that Sheet No. 27A has been corrected to reflect a minimum daily rate for Rate Schedule PAL service of \$0.0000 per dth rather than the \$0.0164 per dth that was reflected on the tariff sheet.² El Paso requests permission pursuant to section 154.205(b) of the Commission's regulations to permit the tendered tariff sheet to be

substituted for its counterpart in the referenced rate case filing. El Paso states that the revised tariff sheet will reduce the minimum daily rate for Rate Schedule PAL service from the rate that was inadvertently filed.

3. The filing was noticed on September 2, 2005, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before September 6, 2005. No protests or adverse comments were filed. All timely motions to intervene and all motions to intervene out of time filed before the issuance of this order are granted pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

4. The Commission will accept and suspend Substitute Second Revised Sheet No. 27A, to become effective January 1, 2006, subject to refund and the outcome of the rate case proceeding in Docket No. RP05-422-000. Second Revised Sheet No. 27A is deemed withdrawn.
