ORDER CLARIFYING TOLLING ORDER

(Issued December 5, 2005)

1. On September 7, 2005, California Parties<sup>1</sup> filed a request for rehearing of three Commission orders: (1) *San Diego Gas & Electric Co. v. Sellers of Energy and Ancillary Services*, 112 FERC ¶ 61,176 (2005) (August 8 Order); (2) *San Diego Gas & Electric Co. v. Sellers of Energy and Ancillary Services*, 112 FERC ¶ 61,220, *vacated and reissued*, 112 FERC ¶ 61,222 (2005) (August 24 Order); and (3) *San Diego Gas & Electric Co. v. Sellers of Energy and Ancillary Services*, 112 FERC ¶ 61,249 (2005) (September 2 Order).

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<sup>1</sup> California Parties are comprised of: the California Attorney General; the California Electricity Oversight Board; the California Public Utilities Commission; Southern California Edison Company; and Pacific Gas & Electric Company.

2. On September 19, 2005, the Commission issued an Order Granting Rehearing for Further Consideration (September 19 Tolling Order). The September 19 Tolling Order mentioned only the August 8 Order, and did not mention the August 24 or September 2 Orders. However, we clarify that the September 19 Tolling Order nonetheless also tolled the August 24 and September 2 Orders. Just as a single tolling order applies to all rehearing requests that were timely filed,<sup>2</sup> so a single tolling order tolls rehearing of all orders for which a rehearing request was sought. This action promotes administrative efficiency.

3. Consequently, we clarify that the September 19 Tolling Order tolled rehearing as to all three orders for which the California Parties requested rehearing: the August 8 Order; the August 24 Order; and the September 2 Order.
