Reference: Order Granting Temporary Waiver

Ladies and Gentlemen:

1. On December 7, 2005, Gulfstream Natural Gas System, L.L.C. (Gulfstream) filed to request a temporary waiver of the Commission's regulations relating to compliance with NAESB Version 1.7 data sets utilizing ANSI X.12. Due to a flood in The Williams Companies, Inc. (Williams) corporate offices on December 5, 2005, the server that facilitates compliance with NAESB Version 1.7 data sets relating to electronic data interchange was not operational.¹ Gulfstream anticipates that the server, which is being relocated to Houston, Texas, will be placed back into service as early as December 7, 2005.

2. For good cause shown, the requested waiver is granted. This waiver is effective December 5, 2005 through the date the affected server is placed back into service. Additionally, to enable customers to obtain relevant data, Gulfstream is required, once

the system is restored, to provide in ANSI X.12 format for a period of 60 days all historic data from the period the system was down that relates to the Commission's reporting requirements under section 284.13 of the Commission's regulations.
