ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED PARTIAL SETTLEMENT

(Issued April 6, 2006)

1. On January 25, 2006, a proposed offer of settlement (Settlement) between American Electric Power Service Corporation (AEP) and Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc. (Wolverine) was filed in the above-referenced proceeding. The Settlement resolves all shift-to-shipper claims by Wolverine against AEP in the above-captioned dockets. The Settlement requires AEP to pay Wolverine a stated amount within 60 days of the effective date of the Settlement. No comments were filed. On March 16, 2006, the Presiding Administrative Law Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested partial settlement, 114 FERC ¶ 63,042.
2. The Settlement is fair and reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2000).

3. This order terminates Docket Nos. ER05-6-036, EL04-135-038, EL02-111-056 and EL03-212-052.
