Reference: Withdrawal of Filing and Termination of Docket No. RP06-316-000

Dear Ms. Bomar:

1. On April 20, 2006, Dominion Transmission, Inc. (Dominion) filed proposed revised tariff sheets<sup>1</sup> reflecting new tariff language it stated was to clarify the liability for any loss of gas in storage, and to provide that its customers are responsible to insure the gas that they own. On May 19, 2006, the Commission issued an order<sup>2</sup> accepting Dominion's tariff sheets for filing and suspending them, to become effective subject to refund on the earlier of a date set by subsequent Commission order or October 22, 2006, subject to the outcome of a technical conference and further Commission orders. On September 5, 2006, Dominion filed a request for permission to withdraw its revised tariff sheets and to terminate the instant docket and technical conference. No protests or comments on the request were filed. The Commission accepts Dominion's withdrawal of its revised tariff sheets and terminates the instant docket.

2. In its request, Dominion states that good cause exists for the withdrawal of its revised tariff sheets and that it will remain self-insured with regard to its responsibilities for storage inventory under the existing tariff, to the extent that any such liabilities are not also covered by existing insurance from third parties.

3. The Commission grants Dominion's request for the withdrawal of its proposed revised tariff sheets and terminates Docket No. RP06-316-000.
