 - Coordinating project planning with other transmission providers and stakeholders.




Local Reliability Planning Process


- PGE will plan its transmission system in accordance with NERC and WECC planning and operating standards.
- PGE will annually review its Transmission Plan and revise as needed.
- PGE will coordinate on local issues with neighboring utilities.

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Subregional Coordination

- PGE is a member of the Northwest Power Pool and a participant of the Northwest Transmission Assessment Committee (NTAC) [members include all CG, NTTG members, and transmission providers not affiliated with either entity.]
- PGE will coordinate its transmission planning activities with subregional groups i.e.[NTTG, CG] depending on which organization's members are affected by PGE's planning activity.



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Regional Coordination

- PGE Participates in regional planning through the WECC planning coordination committees.
- PGE will request the WECC TEPPC to perform regional/sub-regional economic studies.



Planning Coordination Example

Southern Cascade Crossing

- Project concept was presented at Columbia Grid
 - Columbia Grid created a study team to look at West of McNary and Southern Crossing project proposals.
- Engaging other transmission providers to identify common needs.
 - Follow-up with a “synergistic” plan that will engage all stakeholders.
- Project proposal will also be presented at NTAC and NTTG.
 - Review project, assemble study teams, and continue to engage stakeholders.
