Dear Ms. Devers:

1. On November 20, 2008, Saltville Gas Storage Company, L.L.C. (Saltville Gas) filed tariff sheets¹ to reflect enhancements to the LINK® System and the discontinuance of the Executable Contract Summary. Specifically, Saltville Gas proposes to delete all references to the Executable Contract Summary, and to provide that the service agreement, executed either in writing or electronically via the LINK® System by the shipper and Saltville Gas, the exhibits executed by the shipper and Saltville Gas, the applicable rate schedule, the general terms and conditions of the Saltville Gas Tariff and any applicable negotiated rate or discount confirmation will comprise the entire agreement between the shipper and Saltville Gas. The tariff sheets are accepted, effective January 1, 2009, as proposed.

2. Public notice of Saltville Gas's filing was issued on November 24, 2008. Interventions and protests were due as provided in section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 154.210 (2008)). Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2008)), all timely filed motions to intervene and any motions to intervene out-of-time before the issuance date of this order are granted. On December 2, 2008, Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos) filed comments. On December 9, 2008, Saltville Gas filed an answer to Atmos' pleading. Under Rule 213(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice

and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.213(a)(2) (2008), answers to protests are not accepted unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. We will reject Saltville Gas's answer because it does not assist the Commission in making its decision.

3. Atmos asserts that this filing is related to another filing² in which Atmos filed comments and requested a technical conference. Atmos states that, while it is not submitting formal comments to this filing, it believes that the subject matter of this filing should be included for discussion in any technical conference ordered by the Commission related to the proposed modifications to the LINK® System.

4. Saltville Gas's revised tariff sheets are accepted as filed. The Commission finds that Atmos has raised no specific issues regarding the instant filing and, therefore, its request to direct that this filing be addressed in another docket is denied.
