Reference: Request for Withdrawal of Tariff Filing

Dear Mr. Stephens:

1. In an order issued on September 3, 2009,¹ in the above-referenced dockets, the Commission accepted and suspended revised tariff sheets² filed by Texas Gas Transmission, LLC (Texas Gas), subject to Texas Gas's filing additional information. On October 9, 2009, in lieu of this additional information, Texas Gas filed an application for permission to withdraw the tariff filing. As explained below, the Commission grants permission to Texas Gas to withdraw the tariff filing as requested. Accordingly, the tariff sheets set forth in the Appendix are withdrawn.

2. In this proceeding, Texas Gas proposed to remove language requiring semi-annual storage inventory tests from certain rate schedules, and to insert into the General Terms and Conditions language requiring such tests as are "operationally necessary." In the September 3 Order, the Commission accepted Texas Gas's proposal, subject to Texas Gas providing additional information in support of its proposal. Specifically, Texas Gas

was directed to file information about its storage facilities, its current storage field verification process, and its proposed verification process.

3. In the October 9 filing, Texas Gas requests authority to withdraw the subject tariff filing without prejudice to it re-filing at a later time. Texas Gas contends that it would be more appropriate to provide the additional information required by the September 3 Order as part of a certificate proceeding. Furthermore, Texas Gas states it is currently developing proposed changes to the certificates for several of its storage fields, and it commits to file amended certificates within six months of the Commission's approval of its application to withdraw the revised tariff sheets listed in the Appendix. Accordingly, Texas Gas requests authority to withdraw its proposed tariff filing, without prejudice to re-filing at a later time, and to provide the additional information requested by the Commission in the September 3 Order in conjunction with certificate filings within the next six months. Notice of the October 9 filing was issued on October 15, 2009, with protests due on October 23, 2009. No adverse comments or protests were filed.

4. The Commission finds that Texas Gas has shown good cause to withdraw its tariff filing, and therefore, the Commission grants permission to Texas Gas to withdraw its tariff filing in this proceeding. Accordingly, the subject tariff sheets are withdrawn.
