Dear Ms. Horne:

1. On May 24, 2010, you filed a Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) between Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) and PacifiCorp in the above-referenced proceeding. On May 27, 2010, Trial Staff filed initial comments in support of the Settlement Agreement. No other comments were received. On June 2, 2010, the Settlement Judge certified the uncontested settlement to the Commission.
2. The Settlement Agreement resolves all issues set for hearing in the above-referenced docket. The Settlement Agreement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved.
3. If Idaho Power has made its baseline electronic tariff filing pursuant to Order No. 714, and did not file the settlement in the eTariff format required by Order No. 714, it is required to make a compliance filing in eTariff format to ensure that its electronic tariff provisions reflect the Commission action in this order.¹ Such a compliance filing also is necessary for any settlement filing containing pro forma tariff sheets, but is not necessary if the settlement was filed in eTariff format with actual tariff records (as opposed to pro forma records).
4. The Commission's approval of the Settlement Agreement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The

Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms, and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2006).
