Reference: Letter Order on Request for Clarification

Dear Ms. Schwager:

1. On May 4, 2011, Enbridge Offshore Pipelines (UTOS) LLC (UTOS) requested clarification of the Commission's April 29, 2011 "Letter Order on Uncontested Settlement and Non-Conforming Negotiated Rate Service Agreements and Tariff Records Filing."<sup>1</sup> Specifically, UTOS requests clarification that certain tariff records remain in effect as a result of the Commission's approval of the Settlement in this proceeding.

2. UTOS states that its original rate filing in this proceeding<sup>2</sup> included First Revised Sheet No. 25, First Revised Sheet No. 34, and Original Sheet No. 180, which were unchanged by the Settlement or its interim rate filing,<sup>3</sup> and were motioned into effect as of April 1, 2011, pending action on the Settlement. UTOS states that these as-filed tariff records were not referenced in the April 29, 2011 Letter Order and requests clarification that these tariff records remain in effect as a result of the approval of the Settlement.

3. The Commission grants the requested clarification. First Revised Sheet No. 25, First Revised Sheet No. 34, and Original Sheet No. 180 were intended to be approved by the April 29, 2011 Letter Order but were inadvertently not listed in the Appendix to the order listing the approved tariff records. Therefore, those tariff records are approved and remain in effect without condition.

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<sup>2</sup> On September 30, 2010, UTOS filed revised tariff records to implement a general section 4 rate increase as well as to implement certain tariff revisions. The filing was accepted and suspended to be effective April 1, 2011, subject to refund and the outcome of a hearing and settlement judge procedures by the Commission's order issued October 29, 2010. *Enbridge Offshore Pipelines (UTOS) LLC*, 133 FERC ¶ 61,106 (2010).

<sup>3</sup> In its March 23, 2011 Settlement filing, UTOS included a motion pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 375.307(a)(7)(v) (2011) requesting that the Settlement Judge place the Settlement rates into effect April 1, 2011, on an interim basis pending action on the Settlement. That motion was granted by the Settlement Judge on March 25, 2011. *Enbridge Offshore Pipelines (UTOS) LLC*, 134 FERC ¶ 63,024 (2011).
