NOTICE OF INTENT NOT TO ACT

(Issued September 12, 2011)

1. On July 12, 2011, CALifornians for Renewable Energy, Inc., along with Michael E. Boyd and Robert M. Sarvey individually (collectively, Petitioners), filed a petition for enforcement pursuant to section 210(h)(2) of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA), 16 U.S.C. § 824a-3(h)(2) (2006), against Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (collectively, California Utilities) and the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). Petitioners allege that certain CPUC regulations are inconsistent with PURPA.
2. Notice is hereby given that the Commission declines to initiate an enforcement action under section 210(h)(2)(A) of PURPA. Our decision not to initiate an enforcement action means that the Petitioners may themselves bring an enforcement action against the CPUC in the appropriate court.
