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Dear Counsel:

1. On September 13, 2012, Nevada Power Company and Sierra Pacific Power Company (collectively, NV Energy) and the City of Seattle, Washington (Seattle) filed a Stipulation and Agreement (Settlement), which resolves all outstanding issues between Seattle and NV Energy (Settling Parties) in the above-referenced proceeding.

2. Initial Comments on the Settlement were filed by Commission Trial Staff on October 3, 2012, and the Settling Parties filed a Joint Response on October 8, 2012. The Settlement was certified to the Commission as uncontested on October 17, 2012.<sup>1</sup>
3. The Commission finds that the Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and it is hereby approved.
4. This letter order terminates Docket No. EL01-10-107.
