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Dear Counsel:

1. On October 2, 2012, Dynegy Power Marketing, LLC (Dynegy) and the City of Seattle, Washington (Seattle) filed an Offer of Settlement (Settlement), which resolves all outstanding issues between Seattle and Dynegy in the above-referenced proceeding.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> On October 3, 2012, the parties submitted an errata in Docket No. EL01-10-000 to correct an error in Article II of the Settlement, clarifying that the amount to be paid by Dynegy to the City is \$180,000.

2. Initial Comments on the Settlement were filed by Commission Trial Staff on October 22, 2012, and Reply Comments were not filed. The Settlement was certified to the Commission as uncontested on October 26, 2012.<sup>2</sup>
3. The Commission finds that the Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and it is hereby approved.
4. This letter order terminates Docket No. EL01-10-110.
