1. On December 12, 2012, American Electric Power Service Corporation¹ and the
City of Seattle, Washington (Seattle) filed an Offer of Settlement (Settlement), which

3. The Commission finds that the Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and it is hereby approved.
