Dear Mr. Smith, Mr. Reese and Mr. Moeller:

1. On February 27, 2013, you submitted an offer of settlement on behalf of Transource Missouri, LLC (Transource) and the Kansas Corporation Commission, in the above-captioned proceedings. On March 11, 2013, the Commission's Trial Staff filed comments supporting the settlement. No other comments were filed, and on March 19, 2013, the presiding judge certified the settlement to the Commission as uncontested.¹

2. The settlement resolves all issues set for hearing in the Commission's order establishing hearing procedures,² and provides for the withdrawal of Transource's request for rehearing of that order. The settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

4. Article VI of the settlement provides that the applicable standard of review for proposed changes to the settlement is the just and reasonable standard. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms, and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2006).

5. Transource did not file the settlement in the eTariff format required by *Electronic Tariff Filings*, Order No. 714, FERC Stats. & Regs. ¶ 31,276 (2008). Therefore, Transource shall make a compliance filing within 30 days in eTariff format to reflect the Commission's action in this order.

6. This letter terminates Docket Nos. ER12-2554-000, ER12-2554-001, and ER12-2554-002.
