Dear Ms. Walsh:

1. On November 9, 2012, you filed, in the above-referenced proceedings, an offer of settlement (Settlement) on behalf of DATC Midwest Holdings, LLC (DATC). On November 29, 2012, Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On February 13, 2013, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.<sup>1</sup>
2. The Settlement addresses DATC's proposed formula rate template, Attachment O under the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (MISO)<sup>2</sup> Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff.
3. The Settlement resolves all of the issues in dispute in this proceeding. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms and conditions under the just and

reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2006).
