The purpose of this amendment to Solicitation FERC08-RFP-80148 is to provide for several changes to the Request for Proposal. The following changes are hereby incorporated:

1. Section H-1, Key Personnel is hereby amended as follows: One additional key personnel is added to those listed in this Special Provision. ELibrary Operations Task Manager is hereby added as a Key Personnel.

2. The following clause is hereby included in Section I Clauses. This clause is incorporated by reference with the same force and effect as if set forth in full.

FAR 52.227-14 Rights in Data-General with Alternates II and III.

3. Section L-12, Work Breakdown Structure as seen on p. 36 of the RFP, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following in lieu thereof.

A Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) is provided herein. It is noted that the Work Breakdown Structure conforms to the numbering sequence of the Technical Statement of Work. Offerors are directed to prepare the Technical Proposal in accordance with the WBS; however, the Transition Plan should be included in Part B – Management Plan. Failure to utilize the WBS may result in your proposal being judged as non-responsive and thus not eligible for award.

4. A clarification is hereby provided for Section L-16, Proposal Preparation and Section M-3, Evaluation Factors for Award and. The resumes of Key Personnel are to be submitted in Volume IV as indicated in Section L-16. However, the evaluation criteria for these resumes is listed as applicable to Volume III in section M-3. It is noted that the offerors need only submit the resumes in **Volume IV**. The Government evaluators will evaluate them in accordance with the criteria listed in Section M-3.

5. A change to Section L -16, Proposal Preparation is hereby incorporated. The White Paper Appendix should only be submitted on CD – no hard copies are required. Each offeror should submit 10 CD or DVD copies.

6. A clarification is provided for Section L-21, Letters of Commitment-Key Personnel. Section L-21 stated that letters of commitment do not have to be included in the proposal. However, the offeror must provide EITHER: 1) a certification that the proposed Key Personnel are either in it's employ or that the offeror has letters of commitment OR 2) the actual letters of commitment.

7. A change to Section L -18, Part B Key Personnel. Section L-18 Part B Key Personnel delete in it's entirety the following statement as instructed in the Questions/Clarifications Responses, question #70.

"The SOW requirements delineate the total number of personnel required to perform under this contract, and also provide the offeror with the information necessary to determine what level of effort is required for the administration of this effort, or what is commonly referred to as supporting personnel, bearing in mind that all contract work will be performed at Government facilities."
