STAFF NOTICE OF ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

(July 31, 2013)

Take notice¹ that in a non-public, preliminary investigation pursuant to 18 C.F.R. Part 1b (2013), the staff of the Office of Enforcement of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) has preliminarily determined that Enterprise Texas Pipeline LLC (Enterprise Texas) violated Section 311 of the Natural Gas Policy Act (NGPA), 18 C.F.R. § 284.123, and the company's Commission-approved Statement of Operating Conditions (SOC), by charging a title transfer tracking fee without Commission authorization.

Enterprise Texas is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Duncan Energy Partners, L.P., which is indirectly owned by Enterprise Products Partners, L.P. (Enterprise Products).

This Notice does not confer a right on third parties to intervene in the investigation or any other right with respect to the investigation.
