STAFF NOTICE OF ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

(April 1, 2014)

Take notice¹ that in a nonpublic, preliminary investigation pursuant to 18 CFR Part 1b, the staff of the Office of Enforcement (Enforcement) of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) has preliminarily determined that Indianapolis Power & Light Company (IPL) violated section 39.2.5 (c) of the Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff of Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc., by failing to update the real-time offer for its Petersburg 2 generating unit to reflect a derate of that unit.

Enforcement preliminarily determined that IPL failed to update its real-time offer to reflect the derate of Petersburg 2 on July 5, 2012 and again on July 6, 2012.

This Notice does not confer a right on third parties to intervene in the investigation or any other right with respect to the investigation.
