

**Dec. 17, 2003 Homeland Security Presidential Directive/HSPD-7  
- A Driving Force for Why We Are Here Today**

**POLICY (in HSPD-7)**

- It is the policy of the U.S. to enhance the protection of our Nation's critical infrastructure & key resources (CI/KR) against terrorist acts.
- Federal depts. & agencies will identify, prioritize, and coordinate the protection of CI/KR... ..(and) work with the state/local/private sector to accomplish this objective.
- Federal depts. & agencies will ensure that programs do not diminish the overall economic security of the U.S.
- Federal depts. & agencies will appropriately protect information associated with carrying out this objective.
- Federal depts. & agencies shall implement this directive consistent with applicable provisions of law, incl. protecting the rights of U.S. persons.

## **Dec. 17, 2003 Homeland Security Presidential Directive/HSPD-7**

### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (in HSPD-7)**

- Further defines roles and responsibilities of the Secretary of Homeland Security.
- Further defines roles and responsibilities of Sector-Specific Federal Agencies.
  - Energy Sector (excluding nuclear) assigned to Department of Energy
  - Dams (KR) assigned to Department of Homeland Security
- Further defines roles and responsibilities of other Depts. Agencies, and Offices (i.e., State, Justice, Commerce, Transportation, etc.).

## **Dec. 17, 2003 Homeland Security Presidential Directive/HSPD-7**

### **IMPLEMENTATION (in HSPD-7)**

- Produce a comprehensive, integrated National Plan for Critical Infrastructure and Key Resources Protection (to be discussed in greater detail later this morning).
- Establish appropriate systems, mechanisms, and procedures to share information relevant to threats and vulnerabilities in national CI/KR.
- Continue to work with NRC and DOE (protection of nuclear issues).
- Plan Federal Research and Development.
- Develop a program to geospatially map and utilize data for CI/KR.

## **Dec. 17, 2003 Homeland Security Presidential Directive/HSPD-7**

### **IMPLEMENTATION (continued)**

- Develop ways to model implications of terrorist exploitation.
- Develop national indications and warnings architecture.
- Federal depts. and agencies must develop protective plans for their CI/KR.
- Sector-specific agencies will report on activities annually.
- Lead a national security and emergency preparedness communications policy review.


