Dear Mr. Bourne:

1. On December 30, 2004, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) filed proposed revisions to its Open Access Transmission Tariff (SPP Tariff), which would effect a rate change for the Southwestern Power Administration (SWPA) pricing zone under the SPP Tariff. The revised SPP rates are accepted for filing and suspended for a nominal period, to become effective January 1, 2005, subject to refund and subject to the outcome of Docket No. EF05-4011-000, as discussed below.
2. SPP has submitted revised tariff pages to Attachment H (Annual Transmission Revenue Requirement For Network Integration Transmission Service) and Attachment T (SWPA's Rate Sheet For Point-To-Point Transmission Service and Non-Firm Point-To-Point Transmission Service). These revised tariff sheets and rates are applicable to the SWPA pricing zone. SPP requests an effective date of January 1, 2005.
3. Notice of the filing was published in the *Federal Register*,<sup>1</sup> with protests or interventions due on or before January 21, 2005. None was filed.
4. The Secretary of Energy, on behalf of SWPA, has filed for final confirmation and approval for SWPA rates by this Commission.<sup>2</sup> Those proposed rates are the basis for the rates at issue here, and those rates are contested.

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5. Accordingly, the proposed tariff sheets and rates at issue here will be accepted for filing, and suspended for a nominal period, to become effective January 1, 2005, subject to refund and subject to the outcome of Docket No. EF05-4011-000.
