On December 23, 2008, Three Guys Hydroelectric Company LLC (TGHC) filed the Pre-Application Document (PAD) for the proposed R.D. Bailey Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 12683) with the Commission. The proposed R. D. Bailey Hydroelectric Project would be sited at the existing R. D. Bailey Dam, which is operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). On February 12, 2009 the Commission granted the use of the Traditional Licensing Process (TLP) for the R.D. Bailey Project.

This letter is to notify the Commission that TGHC will host the Joint Agency Meeting (JAM) for the proposed Project on Thursday April 2, 2009 from 9:30 am to 12:00 at the Larry Joe Harless Community Center, located at 202 Larry Joe Harless Drive, Gilbert, WV. A site visit to provide a tour of the existing USACE structures and the location of the proposed hydroelectric Project will follow the meeting.

Attached is a copy of the public notice for the meeting, which will be published in the Beckley, Williamson, and Gilbert, West Virginia newspapers next week. In accordance with FERC regulations, resources agencies and interested parties are being notified of the meeting date and location by letter, which is likewise attached. Section 6.0 of the PAD lists issues that may need to be addressed to meet licensing requirements stipulated in 18 CFR §4.51. Pursuant to 18 CFR §16.8(b)(4) written comments and requests for studies will be required within 60 days of the JAM.
