

COMMENT:

Standardized USWMS symbol indicating a mooring. This symbol is used in safe boating classes and is readily recognized by boaters. The symbol is often used on buoys in marinas or other highly utilized boat areas.

RECOMMENDATION:

COMMENT:

Pontoon style boat barrier using the USWMS symbol to prohibit boats. Cable setup prevents turning of buoy in current, boat passage, and can provide a handhold for a swimmer in an emergency. Use of contrasting colored cable or rope can add to visibility.
