NOTICE GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

(September 11, 2017)

Hurricane Harvey has created emergency conditions in the Gulf Coast area of the United States, and Hurricane Irma has created or is expected to create similar emergency conditions in the Southeastern United States. Pursuant to sections 385.101(e) and 385.2008 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.101(e), 385.2008 (2017), the Commission finds good cause to extend until October 11, 2017, for those who need such extensions on account of the hurricanes, the following deadlines that occur on or before October 11, 2017: (1) the deadline for filing forms required by the Commission; (2) the deadline for entities to make other non-statutory filings required by the Commission (e.g., compliance filings, responses to deficiency letters); and (3) the deadline for entities to make filings required by their tariffs or rate schedules.¹
