Information for Public Education

The following are issues typically addressed with public education:

- 1. What people should do if they notice the river is unexpectedly high and rising or they notice a problem with the dam.
- 2. What are signs that a problem is developing at the dam. (This is applicable primarily for residents that live within view of a remote structure.)
- 3. Where people could go to be out of the inundation zone.
- 4. How people should treat moving or deep standing water.
- 5. What residents should do if they are trapped in their house.
- 6. What people should do if they hear a siren or get a Reverse 911 call.
- 7. Who people should contact if they have questions.

These issues should be addressed in consultation with the local Emergency Management Agency.
