ORDER VACATING IN PART AUTHORIZATION

(Issued April 2, 2020)

- 1. On July 17, 2014, the Commission authorized Enable Gas Transmission, LLC (Enable) to abandon and construct certain facilities for its Central Arkansas Pipeline Enhancement Project, including abandoning Line BT-19 by sale to CenterPoint Energy Resources Corporation (CenterPoint).¹
- 2. On March 5, 2020, Enable requested that the Commission partially vacate its July 17, 2014 authorization. Specifically, Enable states that it no longer seeks to abandon and sell the 1,024-foot long Line BT-19 to CenterPoint. Instead, Enable will retain Line BT-19 as part of its system.
- 3. Because Enable no longer intends to abandon Line BT-19 by sale to CenterPoint, we will vacate the authorization to abandon that line granted in the 2014 Certificate Order.
