Dear Ms. Verstuyft:

On November 13, 2019, Enterprise TE Products Pipeline Company LLC (Enterprise TE) filed FERC Tariff 54.48.0<sup>1</sup> to provide emergency transportation service of propane to the Midwest region. Enterprise states that the transportation service reflects a request by a shipper to transport propane from Mont Belvieu, Texas, to Monee, Illinois, in order to meet emergency demand for increased propane deliveries for a period of 30 days, until December 13, 2019. Enterprise TE states that record demand for propane is due to an unusual coincident increase in heating demand, resulting from unseasonably cold weather in the region, and crop drying demand. Enterprise states that the adjustment to accommodate propane service is likely to create operational and scheduling issues and therefore cannot be sustained for a prolonged period of time.

Public notice of Enterprise TE Tariff 54.48.0 was issued on November 13, 2019, providing for motions to intervene, comments and protests to be filed on or before November 18, 2019, and responses to be filed by November 21, 2019. No motions to intervene, comments, or protests were filed. The tariff filing is unopposed.
