Dear Ms. Colby:

1. On December 20, 2018, in the above-referenced proceeding, Wisconsin Electric Power Company (Wisconsin Electric), on behalf of itself and WPPI Energy, filed a Settlement. On January 9, 2019, Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. On January 23, 2019, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.¹

2. The Settlement addresses the revenue requirements for the provision of reactive supply and voltage control from various Wisconsin Electric generating units operating in the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. region effective as of May 1, 2018.

3. Section 4.1 of the Settlement states that

[t]he standard of review the Commission shall apply when acting on proposed modifications to this Settlement under section 205 or section 206 of the [Federal Power Act], including by the Commission acting *sua sponte*, shall be the ordinary “just and reasonable” standard of review.

4. The Settlement resolves all issues in dispute in these proceedings. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in these proceedings.

5. Wisconsin Electric is directed to make a compliance filing with revised tariff records in eTariff format,² within 30 days of this order, to reflect the Commission's action in this order.

6. This letter order terminates Docket Nos. ER18-829-000 and ER18-829-001.
