


- ➤ 1996 Began pilot study on Rice Reservoir; learned that 0.5% Rodeo was effective
- ▶1997 Effort Expanded to include Rainbow, Willow, and Spirit
- ▶1998 Effort continued on Rice, Willow, and Spirit (none observed on Rainbow)
- ➤ 1999 Effort expanded to include Eau Pleine and continued on Rice, Willow, and Spirit (none observed on Eau Pleine)
- >2000 Effort continued on Rice, Willow, and Spirit
- ≥2001 Effort continued on Rice, Willow, and Spirit
- ≥2002 Effort continued on Rice, Willow, and Spirit. Rice sprayed 2 times to test if double effort was needed.




Regeneration during the same year







- 5. Assessing effectiveness of efforts



Purple lossettle is a plant threatening to take over water bodies in Wisconsin, and it exists in Rice Reservoir. The plant has shown purple flower but is crowding out native plants valuable to wildfile.

WVIC began a test enackardon project last year at Ritor Reservoir and would like to expand the project this year to include the entire reservoir (Lake Nokomis, Deer, and Bridge Lakes). We would like your cooperation.

We will spray any areas which you make us aware of, and for which you provide the numes and addresses of adjoining landowners (so we can notify them that we will be spraying a herbicide).




