FERC Approves New Policy for Hydro Preliminary Permits

The Commission voted at the February meeting to implement a new policy regarding preliminary permits for hydropower projects proposed to be located on Tribal lands. Effective immediately, the new policy states that if a project proposes to use Tribal lands and the Tribe on whose lands the project is to be located opposes the permit, the Commission will not issue the preliminary permit.

FERC, NERC to Review Bulk Power System Performance During Recent Winter Storms

The joint review will look at the performance of the bulk power system during recent winter storms that brought Arctic air across much of North America. It will focus on winter preparation activities and gather information to help guide future winter storm preparations and operations.

Report to Congress on Alaska Natural Gas Pipeline

FERC staff sent its 37th <u>report</u> to Congress on progress made in licensing and constructing the Alaska Natural Gas Pipeline.

FERC Staff Issues 2023 Common Metrics Report

The <u>report</u> continues Commission staff's initiative to examine and track the performance and benefits of wholesale electric markets run by Regional Transmission Organization and Independent System Operators.
