FERC Affirms Generator Interconnection Rule

The Commission <u>affirmed</u> its historic July 2023 rule, Order No. 2023, that modernizes the nation's transmission grid by streamlining the generator interconnection process. The Commission also acted on the first Order No. 2023releated compliance fillings.
