ORDER GRANTING CLARIFICATION

(Issued April 19, 2005)

1. Buckeye Power, Inc. (Buckeye) filed a request for clarification or, in the alternative, rehearing of the Commission's February 16, 2005 Order accepting Buckeye's revenue requirement for Reactive Power and Voltage Control for recovery pursuant to the PJM Interconnection, Inc. (PJM) tariff.<sup>1</sup> In this order, we will grant Buckeye's request for clarification. This order benefits customers because it clarifies the effective date of Buckeye's revenue requirement.

**Background**

2. Buckeye filed a petition for approval of a revenue requirement for Reactive Power and Voltage Control from Generation Sources Service for recovery pursuant to Schedule 2 of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT). On February 16, 2005, the Commission issued an order accepting Buckeye's revenue requirement for Reactive Power and Voltage Control for recovery pursuant to the PJM tariff effective as of the date of the order.

3. On March 8, 2005, Buckeye filed a request for clarification or, in the alternative, rehearing with the Commission. Buckeye requests clarification of the intended effective date to clarify that the Commission intended the February 16, 2005 Order to mean that Buckeye's Reactive Power revenue requirement is accepted such that Buckeye may recover the revenue requirement pursuant to Schedule 2 of the PJM OATT for the prospective period commencing on February 1, 2005.

4. Buckeye explains in its request for clarification that it did not object to PJM's request that Buckeye make its Reactive Power revenue requirement effective on the first day of the month in which the Commission approves the revenue requirement.

5. Buckeye seeks clarification that the Commission's ordering paragraph in the February 16, 2005 Order stating that the revenue requirement is accepted for recovery pursuant to Schedule 2 of PJM's tariff "effective as of the date of this order" intended that Buckeye be paid for its revenue requirement for the period beginning on February 1, 2005, as agreed to by Buckeye and PJM.

**Discussion**

6. The Commission grants the requested clarification. Buckeye amended its original application to request an effective date of the first day of the month in which the Commission issued an order on its application. The Commission accepted Buckeye's Reactive Power revenue requirement in an order issued February 16, 2005. Therefore, the Commission finds that the effective date for Buckeye's revenue requirement is February 1, 2005.

**The Commission orders:**

(A) Buckeye's reactive power revenue requirement is effective as of February 1, 2005.

(B) Buckeye's request for clarification is granted.
